Players that have at least \$1 in chip(s) at the beginning of their tables first hand in round 10 will receive an additional \$1,000.

## Hand Rank

Highest to Lowest

### Royal Flush

The five highest cards - the 10 through the Ace - all five of the same suit. A royal flush is actually an ace-high straight flush.

### Straight Flush

Any five cards of the same suit in consecutive numerical order

### Four of a Kind

Four cards of the same denomination.

### Full House

Any three cards of the same denomination, & a pair of a different denomination.

### Flush

Any five non-consecutive cards of the same suit

### Straight

Any five consecutive cards of mixed suits. Ace can be high or low.

### Three of a Kind

Three cards of the same denomination

### Two Pair

Two cards of the same denomination, plus any other two cards of the same denomination.

### One Pair

Two cards of the same denomination

### High Card

Highest denomination card, Ace Highest
